1. Controller Details

The controller of the personal data is Grand Harbour Marina Plc, a limited liability company incorporated in Malta, bearing company registration number C 26891 and having its registered office at Vittoriosa Wharf, Vittoriosa, BRG 1721, Malta, hereinafter referred to as "COMPANY".

2. Personal Data

The term "personal data" refers to all personally identifiable information and includes all the information provided to the Company by you and all information which may arise that can be identified with an individual personally, including information of third party's provided to the Company.

3. Purposes of Processing

The purposes of processing for which the personal data are intended are marketing purposes.

The Company may, from time to time, like to contact you to provide you with information about the Company's services as well as news & events that may be held by the Company, and other information that relates to the service offering provided by the Company ("Marketing").

4. Marketing

Marketing will be carried out exclusively through the circulation of e-mails.

5. Legal Basis

The Company's legal basis for processing personal data for Marketing purposes that have been provided by you is your explicit consent with regard to the processing of such personal data.

6. Recipients

The recipients of the personal data are:

- a. selected individuals within The Company;
- b. The Company's intra-group companies and affiliates; and
- c. agents and third parties that provide services to the Company.

The Company's recipients of personal data are located within the EU.

7. Processing Requirement

The Company will process personal data that you have given us for the purpose of Marketing and follow up as well as for of improving our services.
